United States: You can obtain a "Visa B1" on arrival. You apply and receive your visa once you arrive in Indonesia, Rp500,000 (\$31.50 USD approx.)

Document Requirement: Present the following documents to the immigration officer upon arrival for immigration inspection:

- Passport valid for at least 6 months.
- Outbound ticket from Indonesia.

Day One: Arrival, Villa Check-in & Activities

Airport Arrival

Activity: Enjoy some in-town activities before heading to the villa

Pura Tirta Empul Temple: A sacred Hindu water temple dedicated to the god Vishnu, Pura Tirta Empul is known for its purifying holy spring water. The temple's name means "holy water spring" and it includes a bathing structure where you can participate in a spiritual purification ritual. You can also explore the temple's courtyards and shrines.

2:00 PM: Taxi to Villa Kailasha. For more information about the villa, please see the link above.

3:00 PM: Villa check-in and room assignment.



Day Two: Henna Hands + Balinese Costume Welcome Party

10:00 AM - 12:00 PM: Brunch at the villa.

11:00 AM - 5:00 PM: Collect your selected Balinese costumes. At the Welcome Party, you'll be able to collect your traditional Balinese outfits. Skilled stylists will meticulously dress you and explain the significance of each part of the costume.

3:00 PM - 5:00 PM: Henna application by Tulas Henna Bali (400,000 IDR per artist per hour). The henna celebration honors love and togetherness and is a sign of a blissful married life, vibrancy, and positivity. The intricate patterns can take up to 30 minutes to dry, so you may have to sit still to avoid smudges.

6:00 PM: Welcome party, pictures, and dinner.

Dress Code: Balinese Costume.

Day Three: Wedding Day

10:00 AM - 12:00 PM: Brunch at the villa.

4:30 PM: Wedding Ceremony at the villa.

5:00 PM - 6:00 PM: Cocktail hour and pictures.

Day Four: Tanah Lot Temple Tour

Cost: Approximately \$30 per person.

Booking Information: You can find private tours that combine Tanah Lot with other sites like Taman Ayun and Alas Kedaton Monkey Forest on sites like [GetYourGuide](#) and [Expedia](#). 12:00 PM - 1:45 PM: Group lunch at the villa.

2:00 PM: Pick up for the tour.

3:00 PM: Arrive at Taman Ayun Temple. A 17th-century royal temple, Taman Ayun is known for its beautiful architecture and lush gardens.

4:00 PM: Arrive at the Alas Kedaton Monkey Forest. This forest sanctuary is home to hundreds of native monkeys.

5:30 PM: Arrive at Tanah Lot Temple for the sunset view. This iconic Hindu temple is located on a dramatic rock formation in the sea. It's famous for its unique offshore setting and stunning sunset backdrops.

7:00 PM: Indonesian food dinner at a local restaurant.

8:30 PM: Return to the villa.



Day Five: Full Day Ubud Tour

Cost: Approximately \$114 per person.

Booking Information: Many private tour operators and booking sites offer customizable full-day Ubud tours that include multiple attractions. You can find packages on sites like [Klook](#) and [GetYourGuide](#). We used - [Bali Instagram Tour: The Most Famous Spots](#)

4:00 AM: Boxed breakfast.

Tour Highlights:

Lempuyang Temple (Gates of Heaven): Perched on the slopes of Mount Lempuyang, this temple is famous for its iconic "Gates of Heaven" which perfectly frame a view of Mount Agung.

Tirta Gangga: This former royal palace is known for its water gardens with intricate fountains and koi ponds.

Tukad Cepung Waterfall: A unique, hidden waterfall located inside a cave-like canyon. The best part is when sunlight filters through the top, creating stunning light rays that illuminate the waterfall.

Tegalalang rice terraces: These UNESCO World Heritage site rice terraces are known for their lush, dramatic landscapes.

A local Balinese coffee plantation with a coffee tasting: Here you can learn about the traditional coffee and tea production process, and try various flavors, including the famous Kopi Luwak (civet coffee).

Lahangan Sweet Viewing Platforms: Located in East Bali, this viewpoint offers panoramic views of Mount Agung from various platforms, including a popular treehouse platform. The final stretch of the road is steep, and you can either walk or take a 4x4 vehicle to the top.

The jungle swing at Alas Harum (choose your own activity).



Day Six: Flex Day

Activities (on your own):

Goa Rang Reng Waterfall: Located in Gianyar Regency, Goa Rang Reng is a unique waterfall where the water cascades over a rocky slope instead of a vertical drop. The area is perfect for swimming, with shallow pools and a gentle flow.

Tirta Empul Temple: A significant Hindu water temple where Balinese Hindus go for ritual purification. The temple's spring is a source of holy water, and visitors can participate in the sacred bathing ritual known as melukat.

Vihara Dharma Giri Temple: A beautiful Buddhist temple in West Bali known for its large, white sleeping Buddha statue. It offers a peaceful and quiet ambiance where visitors can roam freely. Donations are expected upon entry, and visitors should wear appropriate attire that covers them from the waist down. You can find more information about this temple on Wanderlog and Trip.com.

Blahmantung Waterfall: Also known as Pupuan Waterfall, this serene destination is nestled within coffee plantations in Tabanan. The journey to the falls requires a 1km hike. You can find more details on Bali Buddies and Bali Star Island.

Jatiluwi Rice Terraces: A UNESCO World Heritage site, these terraces are located at the foot of Mount Batukaru and span over 600 hectares. The views are described as "truly marvelous" and you can walk through the paths and enjoy the landscape. Tour packages that include this site are available on [GetYourGuide](#) and [Klook](#).

Day Seven: Water Park Day Or Mex Cooking School Class

7:30 AM - 8:00 AM: Breakfast at the villa.

Activities:

Waterbom Waterpark: Located in the heart of Kuta, Waterbom is a premier waterpark with a wide variety of rides and a lazy river, all set within a tropical garden.

Tickets: You can purchase tickets directly from the Waterbom [website](#) or through booking sites like [Expedia](#). They offer a variety of ticket packages, including a "VIP Gazebo" option that can be booked online.

Cost: Approximately \$33 per person (includes entry, a gazebo, 2 pizzas, and 6 soft drinks). You can rent a 16-person gazebo for the day.

Cost: Approximately \$49 per person.
